As a devoted public school educator and a firm believer in the right to a free and equal education for all children, I am wholeheartedly disappointed that elected officials in Connecticut are considering using the right to an education as political leverage to force compliance of a medical product that violates sincerely held religious beliefs.

Legislation that would remove the Religious Exemption to vaccination and deny a child the right to an education is a preemptive strike on the civil liberties of a population that has never been proven to cause any harm to others. It is a failure to provide equal protection under the law for a minority group of the population exercising their First Amendment guarantees. Did you know there were 4,200 families on Long Island using the Religious Exemption and not a single case of measles during the outbreak in 2019? Yet all of those children have been *prohibited by law from attending school*.

This type of legislation cannot be applied with any amount of fairness because families that have the financial means will continue to direct the upbringing of their children according to their beliefs. Families with the means will home-school their children, or move, or find a way to deal with the problem in ways that poor families without economic means cannot.

These laws hurt children and they hurt families in order to protect the bottom line for industry giants. As long as we continue to focus on each other for solutions, and not toward the manufacturers of vaccines, we can be sure that there will never be a market incentive for them to create products that do not violate conscience. Laws that promote intolerance and take rights away from families are a demonstration of a group of people doing the bidding of one of the most powerful industries on Earth at the expense of the civil liberties and freedoms of their fellow Americans.

Before we turn to families for solutions, let's ask ourselves:

- Can vaccine manufacturers make products that do not violate conscience with the use of aborted fetal cells?
- Can vaccine manufacturers make more effective products so that those who take them will feel safe and protected and won't need to resort to coercion and force for those that choose not to?
- Can medical professionals pre-screen for vulnerable populations and make necessary adjustments to avoid the type of harm that has led to over \$4 Billion in payouts from the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program?

Market incentives cannot be created by mandating medicine. We must look to the industry for solutions and not to the minority group of families exercising their right to Religious Freedom. **A zero tolerance policy for personal choice and bodily autonomy is a dangerous philosophy to embrace and not one we are used to seeing perpetuated by our own government.**
